

Saving Cookie Dough Notice

Planning a trip? Want to use your Cookie Dough? *Great!*

Girl Scouts in grades 6 through 12 can save their Cookie Dough credits for up to two years to be used towards a GSUSA Destination*, a Council Sponsored Trip, or a troop trip to Girl Scouts of the USA National Headquarters in New York City, the Birthplace of Girl Scouts in Savannah, GA, or one of the WAGGGS World Centers.

For Troop or Service Unit Trips, once your group has your travel destination set:

1. Please **Complete and Submit the Troop Trip Application** including
2. **Troop Budget**,
3. **Participant Roster and Itinerary Information forms** to the program specialist.
4. Cookie Dough may only be used for girl expenses for trips and the total used may not exceed one half of the cost per girl.

Please complete this form and send it to the Waite Park Regional Center prior to the Cookie Dough expiration. We will keep the form on file while you keep your Cookie Dough (in a safe place).

This form must be updated yearly, to keep the Cookie Dough active (in case your travel plans change).

When can cookie dough be saved? Start with the year of travel and work backwards. For example: your travel date of 2025: could mean saving cookie dough from 2023 and 2024 and using 2025 cookie dough to pay for their approved trip.
